Step 1: Determine Boundary School for New Athletes

Step 2: Register at Athletics Clearance.com - Time Sensitive: must complete this before trying out for a team.

Step 3: Tryout at Boundary/Home school and make the team!

Step 4: Complete Sports Release Form.

Academic Eligibility

Students must maintain a 2.0 gpa to compete in athletics

Grade Checks are obtained

- End of October for Fall & Winter Sports
- End of January for the Winter/Spring Sports
- Beginning of April for Spring Sports only

Students that are ineligible will be immediately removed from rosters and unenrolled at Home school - returning to Rancho.

Transportation

Students will be transported to their boundary school for practice.

Athletes enrolled in 6th period athletics at boundary school will have a 5th period athletic dismissal at Rancho

On competition days, if the departure time varies from the start of practice, students must find their own transportation to the school. Info comes from Coach.

Collegial days at Camarillo....depends on the coach.

Athletics as P.E.

If a student has a 6th period practice - with an coach that is onsite for practice- that practice serves as a PE class.

All requirements of that class must be met - for the ENTIRE semester.

Once a season is over, all Rancho students MUST stay enrolled in the semester Athletics PE class until the semester is over to receive credit.

In January, when 1st semester is over - students will return to Rancho on a dismissal until 3rd Trimester begins (unless they are Spring athletes).

If a sport/level does not have an onsite coach who is not on campus until later in the afternoon - they will be dually enrolled in an independent studies class at home school.

Dual Enrollment

Multischool Athletes: to participate at another school as an Athlete - Rancho students are enrolled at that school for a class. Dual Enrollment.

If student is enrolled in 6th period practice - that is their dual enrollment. Varsity and most JV teams. Some Frosh/soph teams.

If student cannot be in a 6th period practice for the ENTIRE semester (if season starts in Winter), they will be enrolled in a 16 week Independent Studies class at Cam/Rio at start of Season.

- This can be a course that will benefit them.
- Details will be worked out with athletes and the Independent Studies teacher at home school.

Challenges Faced 2019-20

Due to Measure A Construction - ALL of the practice fields at ACHS will be under construction during the school year.

Field sport athletes will be practicing at other locations. Logistics have not been finalized.

ACHS coaching staff is in transition.

The following information will be as accurate as we know at this point in time - it will shift and we will adapt as ACHS figures out many details.

Rio Mesa will not have construction on their field until 2020-2021....

9th Grade Athletes

9th grade athletes are encouraged district wide to take PE during the day as most of them are not on Varsity sports and often practice later in the afternoon.

9th grade Rancho Athletes will practice at Cam or Rio during 6th period only if:

1. There is an onsite coach ready for freshman teams at 2 pm
2. There is a practice space available during 6th period for that team.

If not - the 9th grade athlete will be enrolled in PE at Rancho and will transport to the high school after 2:45 for a later practice time. They will be dually enrolled in an Independent Studies class during their season (for a trimester).

Transportation details for 9th grade athletes are in development.

9th grade Athletes at Camarillo High

9th graders on these teams will be enrolled in 6th period Athletics at Camarillo High

- Football (will be practicing at Rancho)
- Cross Country boys/girls
- Tennis girls
- Soccer girls
- Basketball girls
- Track (location to be determined)
- Swim boys/girls
- Softball
- Golf

9th graders on these teams will be enrolled in PE at Rancho and will have a later practice

- Volleyball boys/girls
- Water polo boys/girls
- Basketball boys
- Baseball
- Wrestling boys/girls
- Tennis boys
- Cheer

ALL SUBJECT TO CHANGE

9th grade Athletes at Rio Mesa High

9th graders at Rio Mesa will be enrolled in PE at Rancho and will travel to RMHS for a later practice

- If a head coach, in consultation with the RMHS and RCHS Athletic Directors determine that a particular 9th grade athlete needs to be in 6th period athletics - they will make that enrollment change.
- Very small number of Rio Mesa athletes at Rancho - therefore each athlete will be considered individually.
- Most 9th grade RMHS athletes will be dually enrolled in an independent studies course that benefits their schedule during their sports season.
